Government sector: promoting socio-economic growth – finalists and winner

THE finalists in the Government sector for a project promoting socio-economic growth in KZN are the KZN Department of Education and the KZN Department of Transport.

KZN Department of Education
According to Statistics South Africa, in 2006 KZN had 1.2 million people who could not read and write. As a result of Masifundisane and Kha Ri Gude, the KZN Department of Education has successfully halved this number. In 2006 when it was established, Masifundisane reached 40 000 learners. The total number of learners reached in nearly five years of existence is 567 000.

WINNER: KZN Department of Transport
The KZN Department of Transport launched the Zibambe programme in 1999. Over 40 000 households now receive R460 each month in return for delivering 60 hours of labour to maintain designated strips of gravel road. There are visible signs of improved household nutrition, people are able to pay school fees, and the Zibambe households have been organised into savings clubs which have collectively saved more than R13 million.
