



The Honourable Mr Nkosinathi Mthethwa was appointed as the Minister of Safety and Security in September 2008. The name of this Ministry was changed to the Ministry of Police in May 2009 and Mthethwa's position became Minister of Police. Mthethwa's involvement with the African National Congress (ANC) began over two decades ago. He became a member of Parliament in 2002 and serves as a member of the National Executive Committee (NEC) of the ANC and a member of the ANC National Working Committee (NWC) amongst other roles.

Mthethwa contributed to the struggle against the Apartheid Regime which resulted in his arrest in 1989. Around this time he was also involved with the Klaarwater Youth Organisation, the Food and Allied Workers Union (FAWU) and was Chairperson of the Southern Natal Unemployed Workers Union, an initiative of the Congress of South African Trade Unions (COSATU). Thereafter he spent a decade serving the African National Congress Youth League (ANCYL), including fulfilling the role of its NWC Secretary for 7 years.
